There will be 4 divisional Groups, A Grade, B Grade, Ladies Social and our new comp Mother Daughter which will be held at the Multisports Complex at 108 Fisherman's Road, Maroochydore.

During September through to November we will be running our Fast Five Ladies & Mixed competition and will put out more information later in the year.

### **A/B/SOCIAL COMPETITION**

These competitions will be open to non-school age players with a minimum of 2 underage players per team. The underage players must be pre-approved by SCNA before Registering into this competition

### **MOTHER DAUGHTER COMPETITION**

New to SCNA in 2020 – This Competition allows mothers and teenage daughter (turning 13, 2007 up) to play together in a nurtured environment before they are eligible to play in our ladies competition. The requirements for team entry are: A minimum of Three Mother/Daughter combinations must be included in the makeup of the team.

### **INDIVIDUAL PLAYERS**

Individual players looking to be placed in a team will be required to complete a Player Registration of Interest Form ([see attached](#)) and return to SCNA fixtures. We will do our best to place you in a team for the season. Once you've been accepted into the team, you will be contacted by the team captain who will forward information to register.

**Players must be registered before taking the court on March 24<sup>th</sup>** This is a Netball Qld and SCNA Requirement

## **FEES**
